



An indication of commitment to the IGSL Child and Youth Safe Campus Policy and IGSL Child and Youth Safe Campus Code of Conduct is required by all IGSL Board Members, faculty, staff, students, parents, caregivers, workers, helpers, and volunteers. Each commitment form will be kept on file in the IGSL LDHR (for board members, faculty, staff, volunteers), OPS (for caregivers/helpers/ workers), or LM (students) offices.

Anyone in the school community who has a concern regarding child safety is responsible for notifying a member of the Child Safety Team by submitting a Child Safety Concern Form (preferably online, see link) or in person as soon as possible and within 24 hours. A concern is anything that a member of the IGSL community has seen, heard, or experienced that may be related to child safety (as stated in the IGSL Child Safe Campus Code of Conduct or IGSL Child Safe Campus Definitions of Abuse).

It is the responsibility of the IGSL Leadership Team to ensure every member of the IGSL community (Board Members, faculty, staff, students, parents, caregivers, workers, helpers, volunteers) signs this Child Safe Campus Code of Conduct (before beginning their role at IGSL) and adheres to these expectations.

I declare that:

- I have read and understand the:
IGSL Child and Youth Safe Campus Definitions of Abuse
- I have read, understand, and agree to abide by the:
IGSL Child and Youth Safe Campus Policy
IGSL Child and Youth Safe Campus Code of Conduct
- If as a child, I experienced any situation as described in the IGSL Definitions of Abuse,
• - OR - If I have been accused or found guilty of any behavior as described in the IGSL Definitions of Abuse, I am strongly encouraged to meet with a trained individual (like LDHR, an ISG Leader, an IGSL Counselor, or a professional in my community) to help process and discuss the level of care I received.
- I understand that if a concern is submitted regarding my treatment of children while engaged in my role at IGSL, the issue will be processed according to the IGSL Child Safety Procedures, which includes cooperation with the appropriate authorities (IGSL and legal authorities when necessary).
